ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

All athletes registering for the 2022 Artistic Gymnastics BC Championships will be verified by Gymnastics BC. Any athlete who is not registered properly (i.e. not in the

correct category, registered as interclub or recreational, etc.) will be subject to a \$200 fine (charged to the club) and may be ruled ineligible for the championships.

As indicated in the GBC Operations Manual, a club may not change the category of an athlete after March 1, 2022. It is the club's responsibility to ensure that all athletes are registered in the appropriate category by that date. If you have any questions regarding your athletes and their categories, please contact membership services at membership@gymbc.org prior to the deadline.

COACH ELIGIBILITY Minimum NCCP requirements

NCCP Certification

All coaches must have the appropriate NCCP certification to be on the field of play as per the GBC Operations Manual as well as successful completion of the Respect in Sport (RiS) program. Coaching certification and RiS completion will be verified by Gymnastics BC for all coaches registered for the competition. Coaches with inadequate certification will be contacted to advise them of the situation.

Any coach with missing certification who is found to be coaching on the field of play during the event, will be subject to a \$200 fine.
