## **General Information:**

- There is no march in. All athletes (side A and B) must line up in front of the judges table before the 1st rotation. Participating clubs will be officially introduced and judges will give instructions.
- Athletes do not need to line up in front of judges for other rotations.
- Be ready to rotate as soon as your club group is done competing.
- The competition order is determined by the coaches, for CCP 6 to 8, Aspire and HP.
- The competition order for CCP 9 and 10 is as indicated in the OOP.
- Athletes' cards will need to be picked up from the secretary and submitted by the coach in the correct order to the secretary at the next apparatus.
- If there is more than one club in a rotation, coaches must discuss and agree on the most efficient way to warm up and compete before submitting their cards.
- Instruct your athletes to listen to the name being called by the judges to make sure every athlete gets the correct score. Coaches should check the cards after each rotation to make sure there are no mistakes.
- At the end of the competition, coaches will have 5 minutes to review the results once they become available. If they find a mistake, they should tell the master scorer or competition head judge <u>immediately</u>. Once that time has elapsed, results will be deemed correct.
- The award groups have been set and will not be altered.

## Single panel – 8 rotations:

- Warm up must be completed when the judges arrive at the apparatus.
- On V, UB, BB: Group warm up only.
- On FX, athletes will warm up and compete on both floors. When MAG competes, the athletes can warm up in between (in-and-outs), except for the CCP 9 and 10 sessions, where athletes will warm up as a group.

## Single panel / 4 rotations:

• On V, UB, BB and FX: All warm up will be done in groups. On BB, 5 seconds will be allowed between gymnasts.
